Award: \$20,000, \$5,000 yearly for 4 years

APPALACHIAN STATE UNIVERSITY (Boone, NC)

Merit Scholarships

Requirements: Applicants considered for various opportunities based on intended major, leadership experiences, diversity, and special talent. Indicate leadership and diversity involvement on student profile which should be completed at CFNC.ORG. Many merit scholarships require a 500-1000 word essay (experiences in your life which have led you to your career goal/intended major), letters of recommendation and transcript.

Chancellor's Scholarship, College of Fine & Applied Arts, College of Business, Colleges of Arts & Sciences, Teacher Education scholarships and others also provide scholarships for which requirements vary. Application for admission must be on file for applicants to be considered for scholarships. Interviews are required for many scholarships.

Award: Varies according to scholarship awarded. Ranges from \$500 to \$4,500 per year

MEREDITH COLLEGE – (Raleigh, NC)

Merit Scholarships

Requirements: As recognition for outstanding ability and talent, merit scholarships are sponsored by Meredith College for incoming freshmen. Presidential Scholarship: based on superior academic achievement, intellectual promise, and leadership ability. Renewable; Meredith College Academic Awards: based on superior credentials in academics, and leadership. Also renewable. Thomas Meredith Baptist Heritage: awarded based on academic excellence, outstanding service to church and/or community and leadership ability (must be a member of a NC Baptist Church and be recommended by a church official). Paschal Scholarship for computer science, computer information systems, math, or pre-engineering majors who demonstrate academic potential. Essay required.

Art, Music, Interior Design merit scholarships available.

Award: \$1,500 to \$10,000 annually

- Application:* The Art, Music, Interior Design, Baptist Heritage and Paschal scholarships require a separate application found on-line at www.meredith.edu/admissions.

NORTH CAROLINA CENTRAL UNIVERSITY (Durham, NC)

Chancellor's Cycle of Success Scholarships – All incoming freshmen are considered for the following scholarships when they apply.

Soaring Eagle Scholarship: National Achievement, Hispanic, or Merit Semifinalist by the National Merit Corporation **and** having a 1650 SAT, **or** a high school GPA of 3.5 **and** scores of 1900 on the SAT or 29 on the ACT.

Rising Eagle Scholarship: SAT score of 1800 or 27 on ACT **and** a 3.5 high school GPA.

Eagle In Flight Scholarship: SAT of 1650 or 23 on ACT **and** 3.0 GPA.

Eagle in Flight Scholarship 2: Incoming freshmen who meet the following criteria -SAT of 1650 or 23 on ACT **and** 3.0 GPA, **and** are majoring in Biology, Chemistry, Physics, Mathematics, Computer Science or Environmental Science.

- Award:* Ranging from \$2,000 per year to Full Tuition plus fees, books, \$500 stipend and laptop for 4 years.

- Deadline:* **The earlier you apply for admission the better your chances are for a scholarship** as scholarships are awarded until funds are depleted. Final deadline for freshmen admissions is **August 1, 2008**.

Honors Scholar Program

Requirements: Students are invited to apply to UNCW and the Honors Scholars Program.

About 5% of the freshman class is accepted into the program.

Acceptance is based on high school grades, SAT scores and rank in class.

Recent year's Honors Scholar freshman class had an average SAT of 1290, GPA of 3.9 and had leadership experience in school or the community.

Award: Unique opportunities both in and out of the classroom including small classes, enhanced student faculty interaction, field trips, and priority registration. Includes honors sections of basic studies courses and honors seminars.

Henry Wells Scholars Program

Requirements: **NOMINATION.** Must have a 90% cumulative GPA in a college preparatory program; 1150 SAT or higher or an ACT score of 26 or higher.

Award: Guaranteed first-year internship and eligibility to receive a \$3,000 stipend to support an internship, academic research or related experience. Students receiving awards will have transportation expenses paid by Wells College in order to visit the campus in March 2005.

Deadline: In order to be considered for a nomination, see your Guidance Counselor by **January 23, 2008.**

Park Scholar Awards

Requirements: Award recognizes students who have demonstrated academic and creative achievements in communications, involvement in relevant co-curricular activities and significant community service. Typical scholars were ranked in the top 4% of their class and had 1350 or above SAT scores. Must apply for admission in one of several communication majors, submit essay, resume and three letters of recommendation.

Award: Full cost of attendance, currently \$35,144, plus \$2,500 computer allowance.

Deadline: Application for admission to Ithaca College and the Park School of Communications must be received by **December 15, 2007**. Park Scholar application must be submitted by **January 15, 2008**.

Requirements: Son or daughter of 1) a Marine on active duty or in the Reserve, 2) a former Marine or Marine Reservist who has received an Honorable Discharge, Medical Discharge, or who was killed in the service of our country, 3) an active duty, reserve, or former US Navy Corpsman who is serving or has served with the US Marine Corps. You are a senior in high school and your family income is less than \$63,000 per year.

Award: Range annually from \$500 - \$10,000

DISCOVER CARD TRIBUTE AWARD SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Requirements: **For high school juniors** with cumulative GPA of 2.75 in 9th and 10th grades who are multi-talented, take the lead, have experienced a significant obstacle(s) and who are giving back to their communities. Must submit application, 3 letters of recommendation and write a criteria statement discussing your most significant accomplishments in the following four areas: special talents, leadership, obstacles overcome and community service.

Award: Up to 300 scholarship awards of \$2,500; national scholarship awards of \$25,000. Winners may use the scholarships for training in any area of study leading to certification or licensure in a trade; for study at a technical school or for studies at a two or four year college or university.

THE AMERICAN LEGION NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL ORATORICAL CONTEST

Requirements: Eligible participants in The American Legion National High School Oratorical Contest shall be citizens of or lawful permanent residents of the United States. All contestants must be bona fide students herein described as any student under the age of twenty (20) years on the date of the National Contest who is presently enrolled in a high school or junior high school (public, parochial, military, private or state accredited home school) in which the curriculum of said high school is considered to be of high school level, commencing with grade nine (9) and terminating with grade twelve (12). Students must be enrolled in high school or junior high school during the time of participation at any level

Awards: State winners who participate in the National contest will receive \$1,500 with and additional \$1,500 if advanced to second round. Three Finalists at the National Contest receive scholarships as follows: 1st Place-\$18,000, 2nd Place-\$16,000, 3rd Place-\$14,000.
