### COLLEGES AND UNIVERSITIES

#### WINSTON SALEM UNIVERSITY

##### **Nate McMillan Education Scholarship**

*Award:* \$2500.00 annually

*Application:* See Mrs. Carr in student services

*Requirements:* Must be from Wake County, made an application to Winston Salem State University, and met the university requirements for acceptance. Also must demonstrate financial need, good leadership, good character and personal achievement, must have a 2.5 high school grade point average, SAT scores in excess of 950 (Verbal and Math), and must maintain a minimum 2.5 GPA per year at WSSU to maintain the scholarship.

**Honors Scholar Program**

*Requirements:* Students are invited to apply to UNCW and the Honors Scholars Program.

About 5% of the freshman class is accepted into the program.

Acceptance is based on high school grades, SAT scores and rank in class.

Recent year's Honors Scholar freshman class had an average SAT of 1290, GPA of 3.9 and had leadership experience in school or the community.

*Award:* Unique opportunities both in and out of the classroom including small classes, enhanced student faculty interaction, field trips, and priority registration. Includes honors sections of basic studies courses and honors seminars.

*Award:* Guaranteed first-year internship and eligibility to receive a \$3,000 stipend to support an internship, academic research or related experience. Students receiving awards will have transportation expenses paid by Wells College in order to visit the campus in March 2008.
