

DESCRIPTION

The George A. Kahdy Scholarship Endowment is established as an annual award to a graduation Enloe High School senior who has demonstrated scholarship, service to the school and community, outstanding character and integrity, financial need, involvement in school activities, and is a NC resident.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Be a graduating Enloe High School senior

Demonstrates scholarship

Demonstrates service to and involvement in Enloe High School and the community

Demonstrates outstanding character and integrity

Demonstrates financial need

Resident of North Carolina

CRITERIA FOR SELECTION

Official transcript with grades, cumulative GPA (weighted & unweighted), class rank, and SAT/ACT scores.

Letter of recommendation from a staff member (sealed envelope)

Essay – one page describing the impact such as this scholarship would have on your life, and your post high school goals.

Signed copy of parents latest Federal Tax Form (1040) (pages one and two only) and W-2 forms.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Applicants must return application and additional information to Enloe guidance department by date to be established by Enloe guidance department (February 29). Enloe Scholarship Committee will recommend three to five students to the George A. Kahdy Selection Committee. The George A. Kahdy Scholarship Selection Committee will select the scholarship recipient.

Include the following:

- Complete application

- Copy of transcript

- Staff recommendation

- Your letter

- Parent federal 1040 tax form and W-2 form
