1. Obtain a waiver form from the Office of Student Services, your IB Coordinator or from the Student Services registration section on Enloe's website (enloehs.wcpss.net).
2. Fill in your name, the date, and check the subject area box. Fill in the teacher's name, the course your teacher recommended, and the course you are requesting.

If you are requesting a math or foreign language waiver, please read the important information below.**

3. Present your waiver form to your parent(s)/guardian(s) who will complete and sign the parent/guardian rationale section. Both you and your parent(s)/guardian(s) should read the statement at the bottom of the waiver carefully and thoughtfully before signing to be completely sure you want this waiver honored.
4. Present your waiver form to your teacher who will complete and sign the teacher rationale section. Ask your teacher the best way for your parent(s)/guardian(s) to contact him/her.
5. Attach your waiver form and documentation to your registration form and turn it in at the time instructed.
