

Geometry PLT  
Plan for Intervention

1. Criteria for intervention:  $\leq 75\%$  on a unit test. (A Level III or IV student scores at 76 or higher on the EOC.)
2. Identify student by their academic need:
  - Failed learner – a student who has made poor progress in Geometry at any checkpoint but has completed all assignments and assessments.
  - Non-learner – a student who has made poor progress in Geometry at any checkpoint because the student has not completed assignments or assessments.
3. When are checkpoints?
  - Following a unit test.
4. Interventions for failed learners:
  - PLT tutoring offered Thursdays in 1212.
  - Required teacher/student conference within a week after  $< 76\%$  on a test.
  - Parent/teacher/student conference if student does not show improvement to 76% or higher by the next unit test in a quarter.
5. Interventions for non-learners:
  - Email parent if assignments are not submitted within teacher deadline.
  - Conference with parent/teacher/student if more than 3 assignments are not submitted within a quarter.
