Mandatory Field Trips

9th graders

Project: Health career puppet show at Fuller (4 in-house hours)

- ✓ Required to write short paper and script
- ✓ Attend training session
- ✓ Attend Science day at Fuller

10 in-house hours and 1 S project

10th graders

Project: Health Fair (4 in-house hours) :

- ✓ Required to meet all deadlines for prizes, boards, games
- ✓ Required to attend health fair meetings
- ✓ Required to go at least once to the health fair

10 in-house hours and 1 S project

11th Graders

Project: Health Fair (4 in-house hours) :

- ✓ Required to meet all deadlines for prizes, boards, games
- ✓ Required to attend health fair meetings
- ✓ Required to go at least once to the health fair

10 in-house hours and 1 S project

Job Shadowing

- ✓ Fill out required paperwork on time
- ✓ Show up at designated location and behave professionally.

12th graders

Project: Wake Assisted Living (4 in house hours)

- ✓ Attend planning meetings and fill out required paperwork on time
- ✓ Each person has to go 2 times to the assisted living center to do a planned activity.
- ✓ Turn in signed sheets

Job Shadowing (Required for class of 2009, Optional for classes 2010 +)

- ✓ Fill out required paperwork on time
- ✓ Show up at designated location and behave professionally.

Internship (Optional for class of 2009, Required for all subsequent classes)

- ✓ At least 90 hours
- ✓ Have to turn in paperwork prior to starting and meeting all internship requirements.

CPR Certification and all hours have to be turned in before April 1

Seniors who do not have met all of the requirements by April 1st do not graduate with mbsa standing.
