Call to Order: The meeting was called to order at 7:10 by President Adrienne Lumpkin

I President's Report: Adrienne Lumpkin: Discussed ways to get involved in the PTSA next year. Need an audit committee to go over this year's financial books. Need people to help with Flight School beginning August 10th.

Enloe Safety Committee: Report April 14, 2009 PTSA Meeting.

The PTSA Safety Committee continues to meet. Some of the items that we have focused on during our meetings are:

Work towards better communications by increasing eNews subscriptions. Emails sent to Enloe Staff and various parent organizations about signing up. Feeder middle schools will be contacted also. The PTSA

section of Enloe web site has been revamped with easier access to eNews signup. Additional meeting minutes posted to web site. Student Safety Awareness training scheduled for Tuesday April 21 at 2:30 pm in the school's media center.
