Call to Order: The meeting was called to order at 7:00 by President Adrienne Lumpkin

I President's Report: Adrienne Lumpkin: In closing, I want to congratulate the parents, teachers, administrators and students who have made this a successful year for PTSA. We have had a number of accomplishments and they should not go without acknowledgement.

Our membership grew 13% this year to nearly 1000 parents, teachers and students. We exceeded our membership revenue projections by over \$4000. We have done this despite a down economy, I believe, because parents at Enloe take a sincere interest in the academic success and the general welfare of their children and all Enloe students.

We have made our website current, relevant and more user-friendly. We have re-ignited both Academic Boosters and Eagle Buddies, programs meant to engage, support and recognize our students' success. We have begun our transition to a GREEN Newsletter that will reduce paper waste and provide more timely information to parents. We have supported key teacher initiatives through PTSA grants. We have invested in improving the Grounds around campus. Next week, we'll award a college bound senior our \$2000 scholarship.

Perhaps most notably, we took the bull by the horns and organized and executed actions to address safety concerns at our school. We have weathered this controversy as a school and come out on the other side a stronger community for it. Our Celebration tonight is one more way that PTSA hopes to be a catalyst to bring our school and community together.

I want to congratulate those students and parents who are graduating and thank and all of you who have given your time, talents, ideas and money to PTSA to help us support our children's education and welfare at our school. Thanks, too for supporting me as your president this year and I trust you will do the same for Lorraine as she takes the helm. Please continue to be involved in Enloe and PTSA. Thank you!

II Principal's Report: Dr. Beth Cochran

Dr. Cochran thanked the PTSA, parents, staff and students for a fitting end to the school year with music, artwork and student participation. She reflected upon a tough year, the good and the bad.
