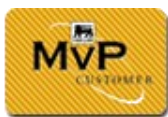
PAINLESS FUNDRAISING! No magazines, wrapping paper or candy!

You will need to give the operator your 12-digit MVP card number, and specify that you want the funds to go to Enloe High School PTSA.

When you purchase select Harris Teeter Private Label Products using your VIC Card, Harris Teeter will give back by contributing a portion of those sales to our school. In store, simply give the cashier your VIC card and the school's code 1796, before your groceries are scanned.

They also have links to local home repair and remodeling businesses. There are no additional costs to you and you receive the exact same products and services. Cash back percentages can range from 3-7% of the total purchases to several dollars for each transaction.

Jennifer Li named SPE "Wonders of Plastics" Essay Contest Winner

Jennifer Li, a senior at Enloe, has won a national essay contest sponsored by the Society of Plastics Engineers. This contest is held annually, and it starts on the local level with essay contests held by local geographic sections of the SPE throughout the US and in several countries overseas. The local section serving the eastern portion of North Carolina is the Piedmont-Coastal section.

Jennifer won the Piedmont-Coastal section essay contest last year, and as an award received a new iPod Touch. Her essay, entitled "Plastics: The Ambient Technology of the Future", was then submitted to the national contest, along with the winners from the other local sections across the US and abroad. The Piedmont-Coastal section of SPE has been conducting this essay contest for 14 years, and Jennifer is the first Piedmont-Coastal section winner to win the national contest.

Jennifer will receive a \$1000 prize and Enloe High School will also receive a \$1000 award. Her essay will also be published in "Plastics Engineering", the national trade journal of SPE.

Eagle Buddies Gather To Celebrate

The Enloe Eagle Buddy program pairs students needing and wanting an adult mentor with Enloe faculty and staff; the focus is on getting these students to attend school regularly and improve their academic performance with an eye toward eventual graduation. Eagle Buddy mentors and students sign contracts agreeing to meet weekly to discuss issues at school and elsewhere that may have a negative impact on student attendance and academic performance.

Begun during the third quarter of the 2008-09 school year, the program has grown to include more than 100 students and around 40 adult mentors (many of the adults mentor multiple students). Rebecca Clark of the PE Department is

the faculty coordinator (and heart) of the program, supported by Kevin Neiley, Enloe's intervention coordinator.

On Tuesday afternoon, Nov. 3, Enloe's Eagle Buddy participants got together after school to celebrate the end of the first quarter. Faculty and students participants in the program came together for awesome brownies, cookies, chips, fruit, and drinks provided by the PTSA and some of the teachers. It was a nice, relaxed time for everyone to chat and hang out together. The Eagle Buddies will be having similar gatherings each quarter, and an awards ceremony at the end of the year.

Enloe PTSA Submits Letters of Intent for Grants from the John Rex Foundation

On Friday, Nov. 6, Enloe's PTSA submitted two letters of intent to the John Rex Foundation, hoping to be selected to apply for grants from the Foundation for projects that "support visible and measurable improvements in the health of children and youth ... by promoting healthy behaviors and by providing opportunities for growth and development." If selected, Enloe will apply for grants to support the expansion of its 9th Grade Academy and the Big Brother/Big Sister student-to-student mentoring program. Christine Kushner of the PTSA did an excellent job of preparing the letters of intent, pulling together lots of information in a short amount of time and distilling it into two, two-page letters. If selected to apply for the grants, there will be much more work to be done by the end of the calendar year; be on the lookout for requests for help.
