PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

Dear Parents/Guardians:

Welcome to the 2008-2009 school year!

Over 600 incoming ninth graders participated in Flight School August 12-15 for orientation, tours and review of their schedules. We hope this opportunity was their first of many successful experiences at Enloe!

Students should have received their schedules in the mail the first week of August. Any schedule corrections should have been made on SPAN before school started.

The senior parking lottery took place over the summer and students were notified if they received a spot. Parking fees were to be paid August 7-13 to secure a spot.

Off-campus lunch passes for juniors and seniors that were not signed in the main office in August can still be notarized and returned to the school. We just want to be sure that parents have authorized juniors and seniors to leave campus during lunch.

Please check the Enloe Web site for the slightly adjusted bell schedule next year. Classes will start Monday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday at 7:25 am. Every Tuesday, classes will start at 7:55 am for students while teachers work in Professional Learning Committees. Busses will run at the regular times and there will be several locations where students can go to until classes start at 7:55 am. Students who drive to school are welcome to sleep in a little on Tuesdays. We are really excited about this opportunity for our teachers to collaborate!

SAVE YOUR ENLOE DIRECTORIES

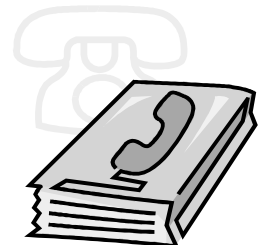
Please note that PTSA will not publish a 2008-2009 Student Directory.

We are no longer allowed to use an ‘opt-out’ method as we have done in the past. This method made it relatively easy to ensure that the majority of students were listed—deletions from the entire school body were on an exception basis and we had no requirement to track people down.

Legally, we are now required to use an ‘opt-in’ method and collect the contact information and parent signature from every student to include them in the book. This process would be unwieldy and imperfect to say the least.

Many high schools are re-evaluating their plans for a directory. We encourage returning parents and students to save their directo-

ries from last year and encourage new parents to come to PTSA meetings to network with others and collect their contact information in person!
