 - Parents urged to join for free sign-up to e-news (Parents' Email Group) and receive school news every Monday morning. Goal is to have 1,000 parents sign up.
 - School bond issue for construction funding comes up for a vote in early November. Several Enloe projects will be covered: West Building renovations, arts and television studio. Parents are encouraged to vote.
- PTSA Programs
 - Eagle Pride: partnership with parents, faculty and other student government leaders to promote safe driving. A series of events are being planned. Parent volunteers are needed; sign up tonight. More details on e-news.
- Budget Highlights & Voting
 - Copy of recommended budget from PTSA board appears on the back of Open House program.
 - The budget is funded through PTSA membership, so please join.
 - Teacher mini-grants program is larger this year.
 - This is year 3 of funding for new activity bus. PTSA sets aside \$2,000 each year for 5 years to pay for bus.
 - Parents were asked by a show of hands to vote to accept the recommended budget. Classroom teachers were asked to count those in favor and those opposed and pass numbers in at the main office.
- PTSA meeting was adjourned by Julie Phipps at 6:40 PM.
