

SUMMER SCHOOL GRADING PROCEDURES

- All Summer School Teachers must maintain grade books.
- The teacher's name, course, and contact number must be written on the grade book
- Grade books are the property of the school and are collected at the end of Summer School by the school administration.
- All grades should be calculated and recorded in compliance with WCPSS grading policies and procedures established in the 2007-08 school year.
- Teachers must use percentage grades when recording in their grade book. If a teacher uses a code or alternate system for grading, there must be a written explanation or key included in the grade book.

A = 93 - 100 B = 85 - 92 C = 77 - 84 D = 70 - 76 F = less than 70

I = incomplete

WF = withdrawal with an F

FF = failed for violation of attendance policy

NORTH CAROLINA END-OF-COURSE TEST REQUIREMENTS

End-of-Course (EOC) Tests will be administered for the following courses:

Algebra I	Biology	English I	Physical Science
Algebra II	Chemistry	Geometry	Physics

In all courses with an End-of-Course test, the EOC test shall count as 25% of the student's final grade. In courses without an End-of-Course test, the final exam shall count up to 20% of the grade.
